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# What if Everyone in a Local Church Loved God (With Their Whole Heart?)

Few causes will ally groups that are normally at odds with one another. However, Jesus was the catalyst that united two groups that were diametrically opposed to each other. This revolutionary teacher brought the Sadducees and Pharisees into a collusion to halt the progress of the movement which Jesus had initiated. After the Sadducees were silenced by His wisdom, the Pharisees stepped in and sent a lawyer (probably one of their best) to test Him. He asked, "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?" Jesus said to him, "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and great command." Jesus continued with a second command, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets" (Matthew 22:34-40). Everything that God desires of people can be summed up in the statement, "Love the LORD your God with all your heart, soul, and mind." Everything that He wants man to do in his relationship with his fellow human beings is encapsulated in the command, "Love your neighbor as yourself."

What is the result when an individual loves God with their entire being? How does this love manifest itself in the life of this person? The simple answer is that whoever loves God with their whole heart, soul and mind will display a voracious desire to please Him. Just as a doctor looks for symptoms of a particular illness that cannot be seen with the eye, one can examine the lives of others, as well as their own, in order to identify those individuals who possess such love in their hearts.

Those who possess this whole-hearted love for God will mimic His dispositions and attitudes in their lives. Just as God loves all individuals and seeks their well-being, the individual whose heart is filled with this love will do the same. God even loves those who are His enemies, and so will the person who has the love of God in their heart. Integrity, justice, mercy, and for-

giveness are some of the traits that will characterize the attitudes of those who love God with their entire being.

People who wholly love God will abhor evil (Romans 12:9). These individuals will abstain from sinful behavior due to the attitude that they have toward evil. The one whose heart is inclined to God hates evil. The psalmist wrote, "You who love the LORD, hate evil..." (Psalm 97:10). The purer one's love for God, the less allurement temptation and sin will have in the life of that individual.

Another trait which will be displayed in the life of one who loves God with their entire being is the yielding of their will to His. This person's life will be characterized by obedience to His commandments. Jesus said, "If you love Me, keep My commandments" (John 14:15).

What would be the result if every member within a local family of God shared this of type love? Can you imagine the tremendous impact this would have both within and outside of the body? It would obviously lead to harmony within that body. The members of that congregation would possess true love and concern for one another. Peter expressed this thought, "Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart" (I Peter 1:22). thing within their power to lift up "By this all will know that those who were facing trials, illnesses, you are My disciples, if you and challenges in their lives. If this love existed in each individual, noth-John 13:35 ing would be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness

of mind each person would esteem others better than himself. Other's interest would be placed on an equal level or ahead of one's personal well-being (Philippians 2:3-4). The Holy Spirit admonished, "And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works" (Hebrews 10:24 NKIV) "Behold, how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell in unity!" (Psalm 133:1) Our Lord drew this conclusion, "By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:35).

If every member of a local body had this depth of love for God, the message of Jesus Christ would be heralded throughout that community and beyond. Those members would possess a zeal for the gospel that could not be guenched by the opposition of the world or by rejection of the gospel by those who hear. This group of Christians would be a beacon shining brightly in a dark and stormy world.

One might ask, "Is it possible for such a congregation to exist?" "Is it conceivable that every member in a local family of God would possess such love and devotion to their Creation and Savior?" The answer is, "Yes." However, it is only possible if YOU and I develop and maintain this kind of love in our hearts. Will YOU do your part?
